

VISA

Slovakia is one of the 25 countries making up the Schengen area, and thus accessible for most Schengen visa holders and residents of EU member states without an additional visa. Detailed information on visa requirements is available on the website of the [Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs of the Slovak Republic](#) and from the visa department of your home country or [Visa centers \(online application form\)](#). On the website above, you will also find detailed instructions regarding the visa application process, should you require a visa to enter Slovakia.
